DIRECTIONS

FROM EAST: Mass pike to exit 4, (Route 9 North) then take exit 19 (Rt. 9) at end of ramp lights, take a left onto Route 9. Take 1st left onto Ferry Road. The arena will be on our right. **FROM WEST:** Route I-91 south to Exit 20, left at light onto Damon Road, right at lights at intersection onto Route 9 then take first left onto Ferry Road. To qualify for a circuit award the same exhibitor/horse combination must show in all three shows. They also **MUST SHOW** in their **appropriate halter class** to qualify for a circuit award. VQHA Circuit Awards will be calculated according to AQHA all around rules with weekend high point exhibitor being winner of circuit award. (NSBA points will **NOT** count towards circuit awards)

HALTER LOTTERY

Five halter lottery prizes will be offered this year. The drawing will take place one half hour after the last halter class on Saturday. A lottery ticket is awarded to each horse out of the AQHA points. For example if there is a class of 8 horses the 1st place horse receives one AQHA point; 2nd place one-half point; 3rd place 1 lottery ticket; 4th place 2 lottery tickets; 5th place 3 lottery tickets; 6th place 4 lottery tickets; 7th and 8th places get 5 lottery tickets. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to get their tickets into the lottery bucket for the drawing.

HORSES ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS AFTER 2 PM THURSDAY JUNE 10

All horses entering the grounds must meet Massachusetts Health Requirements including Negative Coggins with 6 months (out of state) and one year (in state). All horses remaining on the grounds overnight must have a stall. Day horses showing out of a trailer must park in the designated parking area and pay the trailer fee of \$25 per horse/per day. Shed row stalls are available for the weekend rate of \$80 per stall while all other indoor portable stalls are available for the weekend rate of \$90 per stall. Shavings will be available at market price. Pre-order shavings by Monday, June 7 and they will be delivered to your barn. RULES AND REGULATIONS

STRICTLY ENFORCED BY AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL

No vehicles, campers, trailers allowed to park in **FIRE LANES**. This includes parking between the barns or within the aisles. Massachusetts Law requires HELMETS be worn by all bicycle or scooter riders under the age of 16.
No motorized vehicles may be driven by an unlicensed person.
NO scooters, skateboards or bicycles may be ridden in or around the arena or in the barns.
DOGS MUST BE KEPT TIED or ON A LEASH (with person attached) AT ALL TIMES...
Dogs brought into the arena MUST be quiet at all times or they will have to leave.

PLEASE HELP KEEP YOUR COSTS DOWN

All trash **INCLUDING SHAVINGS BAGS** must be put in the dumpsters provided at each barn. **PLEASE...NO TRASH IN THE MANURE PILES.....PLEASE**. This results in additional charges which must be passed on to you the exhibitors.
The **GOLD VALVES** on the water lines **ARE NOT** regulators and must remain on the lines. They are back flow valves and must not be removed from the water lines. Missing valves will be billed at \$15 each.
